Recorded Speech:

Length: Minimum 2 Minutes

Purpose: Persuade your audience on topic of your choice

Content: Introduction that grabs the listeners' attention. The body of the speech includes pathos, logos and ethos. A conclusion that is a call to action for what your audience should do now.

Delivery: Volume (not too loud, not too quiet), Pace (not too fast, not too slow), Vocal Variety (your voice goes up and down and contains emotion) Mostly free of filler words (umms, likes, pauses)
