Unit 3: Character Analysis Powerpoint Presentation

Analyze **ONE** of the characters from the novel you read (*The Adventures of Huck Finn or Of Mice & Men*) by drawing inferences from his/her dialogue, actions, thoughts, and interactions. Share your findings in a PowerPoint presentation.

You will need to select quotations from the beginning, middle and the end of the novel to give a complete analysis of the character.

For each quote, write 2-3 sentences of your opinion on how the quotation reveals the character. The only source you will need is the novel. You should not be citing or using other sources.

How you will be graded...

1. Title Slide

- a. Your Name, Mrs. Hollod, English 10, Date
- b. Title

2. Introduction Slide

• One-sentence thesis statement. A clear and concise statement that describes the analysis of the character.

3. 5 Body Slides

- a. Each slide needs a title
- b. One short quotation from the novel, in quotation marks. At the end of the quotation, put the page number in parentheses. Your chosen quotes need to be powerful, supportive and appropriate.
- c. Follow with your unique opinion on how this quotation supports your thesis.
- d. Relevant and appropriate graphic. (At least one image per slide)

4. Conclusion Slide

- Restate your thesis and sum up your main points.
- 5. Works Cited Slide
 - Cite the novel using a MLA citation generator

6. Overall appearance of the slideshow

- Punctuation, grammar, spelling
- Slides are visually appealing
- Effort is shown in the creation of the slides
